***The Access 303 features two sails and is available in single seat and wide seat models.***

Like the 2.3, the wide seat model can be sailed by one or two persons, however the 303 has a greater carrying capacity, along with more ballast and sail area. Over 350 of this ISAF Recognised class are sailing worldwide.

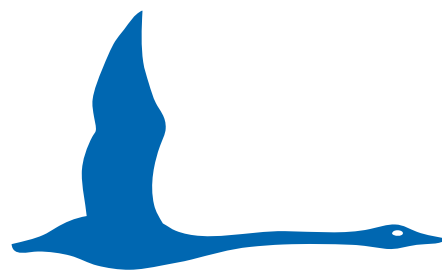
